Typing the hasanta (<Shift>6) between two consonants will display a conjunct if one exists in the font for that combination, otherwise the hasanta will be displayed. e.g.:

k^k displays: ক্ক
t^r displays: ত্র
m^k displays: ম্ক

The hasanta will automatically display the Bengali form (়) when it is word-final: দাষ্

To force display of the explicit hasanta between two consonants which would normally form a conjunct, use <Ctrl><Alt>6 in place of <Shift>6.

To force display of the Bengali form of hasanta, use <Shift><Ctrl><Alt>6.

Note:

<Shift>S is a shortcut for ^s
<Shift>L is a shortcut for ^l
<Shift>V is a shortcut for ^t
v is a shortcut for ^r

eg: pS প্‌ (= p^s)
eg: AL অ্‌ (= A^l)
eg: sV স্‌ (= s^t)
eg: pv প্‌র (= p^r)
